

CHAPTER-ONE
MANAGEMENT OF INDIAN CIVILIZATION – PATRIARCHY
(ECONOMY)

Since beginning we have seen 3 types of systems –

Rise & Fall of Civilisation :

- (i) Governing by one person as dictator (1st stage)
- (ii) Governing by one class of society (2nd stage)
- (iii) Governing by the people (3rd stage)

Though the Democratic way of Management of society is the best management, because it is managed by the people. The existing civilisation has developed and since reached to 3rd stage i.e. **DEMOCRACY, IT IS ALSO AT THE VERGE OF COLLAPSE, UNTIL THE CONCEPT OF EXISTING MANAGEMENT I.E. FROM 'RULERS' AND THEIR ATTITUDE 'TO GET SERVED' IS TRANSFORMED TO 'SERVERS' AND THEIR ATTITUDE 'TO SERVE'.**

How to Avoid Perish of Existing Civilisation ?

A. Conceptual transformation of beliefs :

It is to be understood that matter is from the energy and not otherwise. **Therefore universe is mother and matter is its produce.** Therefore every human being of earth planet is product of invisible radiation energies and visible matters in equilibrium. So is true for entire civilisation.

God/Nature is therefore a greatest server of civilisation like parents who serve us 24 hours, all kind of energies for survival. This concept of God/Nature may prove to be a major source of attitudinal & systems transformations and production of positive emotions. That is love, trust & confidence among the member of the families between societies within a nation, and between the nation of the earth planet.

To reciprocate nature is the life, reverse is death.

B. Conceptual transformation of attitudes :

ONE OF THE GREATEST MISTAKES MADE IS TO CONSIDER NATURE/GOD AS A MASTER/RULER OF ALL LIVING CREATURE. THE CONCEPT OF THE MASTER/RULER AS UNDERSTOOD BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC IS :

- (I) **ACCUMULATED INCOME AND WEALTH**
- (II) **ATTITUDE TO GET SERVED**

OWING TO THIS CONCEPT OF MASTER/RULER, THE OBJECTIVE OF EVERYONE IS TO BECOME MASTER/RULER IN HIS LIFE THROUGH ACQUIRING INCOME/WEALTH AT ANY COST. OPTIMISATION OF DESIRE - EQUILIBRIUM :

- (a) **The maximisation of happiness is the product of minimisation of desire and maximisation of virtues.**
- (b) **Whereas the maximisation of grief is the product of minimising of the virtues and maximisation of desire.**

Desire is a cause of evil, explains all religious constitution, whereas desire is cause of economic development, explains all national constitutions. As long as desire is managed within the legitimate means of men/nation that remains virtuous and happy. However, incremental desire start loosing their virtues and happiness.

Similarly attitude to serve (duties), explains all religious constitution whereas attitude to get served (rights), explain all political/national constitution. Therefore, there is a confrontation between natural law and social law and their followers has to perish. ALL RELIGIONS CONSTITUTIONS ARE DUTY ORIENTED AND ALL POLITICAL CONSTITUTIONS ARE RIGHT ORIENTED AND BOTH ARE NOT IN A HARMONY AS ON DATE.

Slavery V/s Freedom :

- 1. **Freedom is directly proportional to 'attitude to serve'. The act of slavery, therefore, is directly proportional to attitude to get served.**
- 2. **Free people respect the laws and therefore disciplined, whereas slaves break the laws and are undisciplined.**
